Membership Criteria

Application criteria includes:

1. Individuals/Organizations must support the NHTDWG Mission Statement. (See Below)

Mission: The mission of the National Human Trafficking & Disabilities Working Group is to prevent the trafficking of individuals with disabilities and Deaf individuals and to advance the health and wellbeing of trafficking survivors with disabilities and Deaf survivors of human trafficking through research, policy analysis, technical assistance, and training.

- 4. Participate in at least 3 out of 4 quarterly conference calls.
